SESAME PLACE 2013 GROUP TIPS

PARKING:

- General Parking Lot \$17/ Preferred Parking Lot \$20 / VIP Parking \$30
- Bus Parking (in General Parking Lot) \$20
- For safety and maneuverability concerns, the only approved drop off area is in the General Parking Lot near the exit gate. Buses are not permitted in the Preferred Parking Lot.

TICKETS:

- All guests age 2 and above are required to have a ticket for admission to the park.
- All pre-paid ticket orders of 15 or more, must be purchased at least fourteen days prior to the group visit. Any additional tickets needed after the order has been placed, must be for a minimum of fifteen tickets (before the fourteen day deadline) or purchased at the park on the day of your visit at the Group Walk-Up Rate of \$54.56 per person.
- To avoid any delay, group leaders should distribute a ticket to every group member, just before entering the park.
- *Sunny Day Tickets are issued if it rains continuously for one hour while a guest is in the park. Guests that are leaving the park during the time it rains may trade their admission ticket at Guest Relations for a new Sunny Day Ticket to return for a future visit. Tickets must be exchanged on the day of your visit at Guest Relations and you will receive (1) Sunny Day Ticket for every paid admission ticket you turn in. Complimentary tickets are not eligible for Sunny Day Tickets.
- If you leave without exchanging your tickets, you will forfeit the Sunny Day Ticket.
- Tickets are non-refundable, non-transferable and not for resale.
- Sesame Place is not responsible for lost or stolen tickets.

COOLERS:

- Sesame Place does not allow guests to bring coolers or picnic lunches inside the park. However, small coolers for baby food or medicine are permitted. The maximum size of an acceptable cooler is 7 quarts or no larger than 12" x 10" x10".
- If you choose to bring a picnic lunch, two picnic areas are available outside the park, one in the Preferred Parking Lot and the other in the General Parking Lot. Leave your lunches in your cooler in your vehicle.
- If leaving the park to enjoy your picnic lunch, please have your hand stamped for re-admittance.
- Barbeques and charcoal grills are prohibited in the Sesame Place parking lot and Picnic Areas.

LOST PARENTS / FIRST AID:

- Lost Parents and First Aid are located near Cookie's Café, by the Sunny Day Carousel.
- For lost items, please check our Lost and Found, located at the Welcome Center.
- There is no personal paging at the park; therefore, group leaders should periodically check Lost Parents and First Aid for members of their group.

FOOD ALLERGIES AND DIETARY RESTRICTIONS:

HELPFUL HINTS:

- Be sure to bring a bathing suit and sunscreen when coming during our summer months.
- Set-up a designated group "meeting area" inside or outside Sesame Place's front gate.
- Group Meal Certificates can be redeemed in Elmo's Eatery, Cookie's Café or Captain Ernie's Bistro. Additional Group Meal Certificates can be purchase at Guest Relations for \$9.00 each.
- Line cutting or saving a space in line for other group members at any attraction or show is prohibited. Those found line cutting are subject to removal from the park.
- For best viewing of our "Neighborhood Street Party Parade" please locate a spot along our parade route at least 20 minutes prior to parade time.
- Please have your hand stamped if you exit the park and plan to return later in the day.
